AUTHORIZED CENTRAL STORAGE (ACS) TRAINING FOR CLAN LAB CERTIFIED TECHNICIANS

The Tennessee Dangerous Drugs Task Force (TDDTF), formerly named the Tennessee Methamphetamine and Pharmaceutical Task Force, will be holding two separate 2.5 day Authorized Central Storage Container Training/Certification classes at the Fire Academy in Bell Buckle, TN, January 31-February 2, 2017 and June 13-15, 2017. There is no charge for this course. Class will be from 8:00 a.m. (CST)-5:00 p.m. CST the first and second days with a half day planned on day three.

This training will provide certification in adulterating, neutralizing, transporting/hauling and the packaging of clan lab material and will include regulatory procedural requirements. **This is a required class for all Clan Lab Certified Techs and you must be clan lab certified in order to attend.** NOTE: If you attended a previous ACS class within the last five years or a Basic Clan Lab Certification Training Course within the last two years, you are not required to attend this type of training. However, you may attend this training as a refresher course as some procedures may have changed since then. POST Credit (22 hours) will be available for this course.

An updated physical will be required for this class. If one is on file at the TDDTF office that is not over 1 year old from the date of training, that will be sufficient. The class will be filled on a first come first serve basis and we are accepting 40 students per class. If you make the cutoff, a blank medical form will be included in the e-mail advising you of your acceptance in the class.

Most costs associated with this training, including lodging, meals, investigative equipment and supplies will be paid for in advance by the TDDTF. Overnight accommodations have been reserved at the facility and meals will be served on premises. Attendees will have to incur at their own expense, transportation costs to and from the training site. Students within commuting distance (50 miles) are not eligible to stay overnight; however, they may stay at the facility at their own expense.
